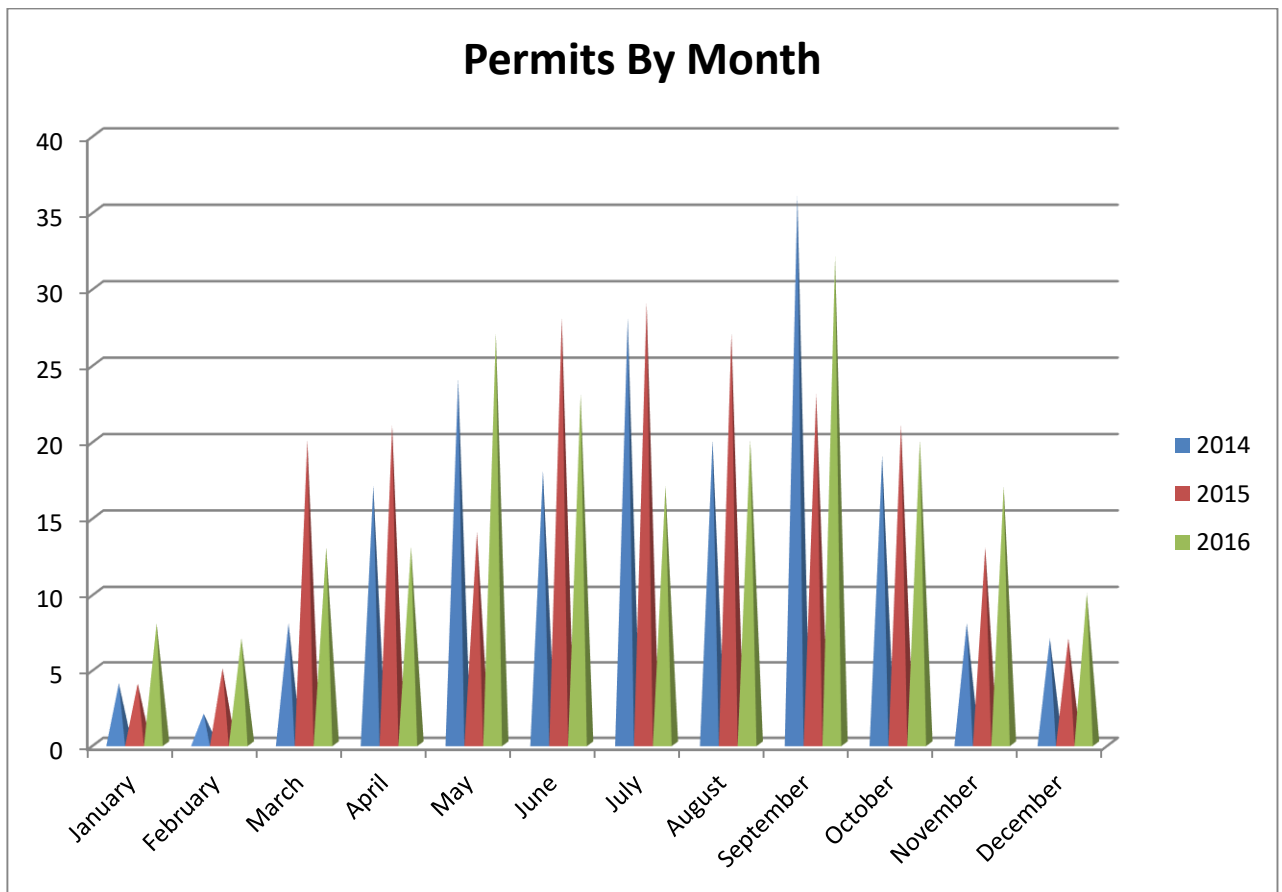
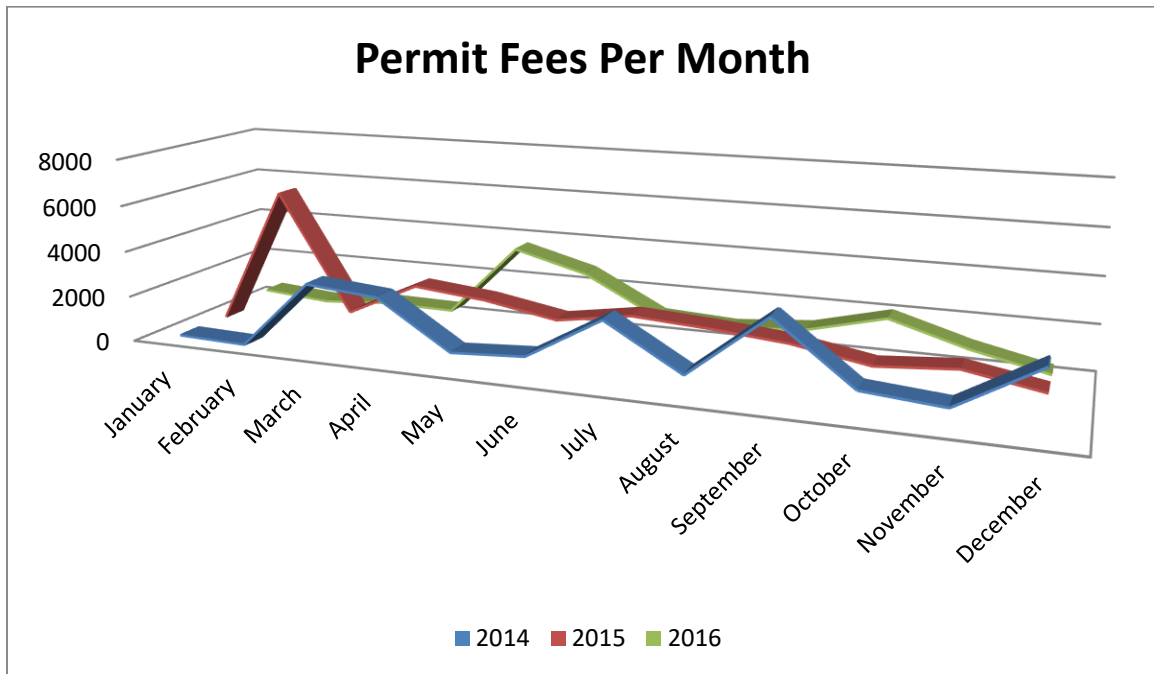


The chart above show the types of permits that were issued within the City. A comparison of how many and what type of permits are issued within the City over the past three years. A total of 182 permits were issued during the year of 2014 with 2015 having 230 issued permits and 2016 totaling 211.



A month to month comparison over the past three years shows that permits are obtained during the warmer months, with a large spike just before the long winter of Wisconsin sets in.



The past three years of permit fees shows the inconsistency due to the type and style of the permit issued. During the construction months, which is when most permits are issued the projects differ each year changing the permit fees from year to year.

Fees are based off of the type of permit that is being obtained. The size of the project and or the cost of the project will dictate what the cost of the permit will be.
