6. Discussion/Possible Recommendation on:
  - a. Ordinance Section 15-1-20 State Uniform Dwelling Code Adopted

  - b. Ordinance Section 5-2-9 Open Burning  
Reed explained that the existing ordinance contradicts itself in that it states in one section that burning of leaves is not allowed and in another section states that leaves can be burned with a permit. He suggested removing that section that states that leaf burning is not allowed. Any complaints will be dealt with as they come in.
