- 3. Approval of agenda as presented was moved by D. Reed and seconded by Trepanier. (9 Ayes)
- 4. Public Input/Correspondence: None.
- 5. Discussion/recommendation/updates/progress reports on the following: Mohr distributed the Phase II results of the Coalition. (See handout) Included are questions which will help processing each item. State the Agenda Harbor Mission/Vision on future agendas. (It will be evaluated at a future meeting.) How do we market our good fishing? Mohr recommended we take action. Wittkopf suggested the work return to the Harbor Commission and then Aldermen; Viestenz was in agreement. Motiff suggested the Park and Recreation Committee also take interest in Phase II at their meetings. Tourism too should look at it.
- 6. Harbor Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT)

It was agreed that Administrator Sara Perrizo include the Harbor mission statement on their agenda in the future.

The MAINTAIN issue was addressed: The City website and Yacht Club need to picture and highlight our lit buoys.

- Also it was discussed to get a bait machine at the Dock Side or Harbor with an appropriate vendor.
- Mohr stated that Bay Lakes Costal Management has annual Grants (60/40) on large projects once a year (they are paid through the County): such has potential. We must be present to see it through for consideration.
- Viestenz expressed that Mohr as moderator has helped us establish a good long term tool. He also noted that the Marina Operator's Association (MOA) contact is mentioned herein 4 times: we should contact them as our association could be very helpful.
- Mohr expressed that he remains reachable for the issues established.
