Northeastern WI Forest Health Update WI/DNR— For the most part, we are receiving the media now. Werner noted the EAB map as optimistic... no EAB in Oconto County and it appears to be in only one hot corner (SE) of the State. Oak Wilt can be observed on a map therein also.

- 7.) Discussion/Recommendation/Action on the Following:
  - a.) Tree City Growth Award—Bostedt is completing application for 2017 (due 12/31/17). Werner noted criteria which expected to spend \$2 per capita on Forestry: the present status. TABLED.
  - b.) 2018 Poster Contest— Members are to be considering a topic for 2018. Presently we are considering "3 other benefits". To be noted in P.R. that 90% of the posters will be displayed. A standard paper size was also in discussion. Info should be out by the end of Feb. or March.
  - c.) Shopko Oconto Plantings (15-16) by New Sidewalk/Charles St. and Bralick Way—Bralick Way will be replaced by the City: students will plant in late April/early May.
  - d.) Main Street White Lilac Planting 2018 will include the 2 terrace trees @ the Governor Scofield Mansion, and any up Main Street that did not survive the winter. Here Sasse shared a handout of tree species with mature heights appropriate for public terrace strips: valuable future resource.
  - e.) Nursery Trees (variety) for Main St. and Other Future Planting Projects—See above.
  - f.) 2018 WAA/DNR Annual Conference Green Bay February 18<sup>th</sup> -20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Although Chairman Werner will be unable to attend, members have foresight as to when and where. (The Conference signed a contract for the G. B. site the next 4 years.) A flyer is to follow.
