- 6. Correspondence: McDonald Street Construction update included the map and planning (Handouts were given to Board members.) explained since Wusterbarth's project inspection: changes (culvert and pipe sizing) were discussed. Homeowners on McDonald Street were sent a letter with preliminary assessments (@ possible less cost) and an explanation behind it. Payment choices and the public hearing date were within.
- 7. DISCUSSION/RECOMMENDATION/ACTION ON THE FOLLOWING:
 - a) Schaden called motion to approve a bid for Holtwood Way reconstruction in the amount of \$151,906.45 from KCG Construction out of Oconto Falls. Daul called second. (4 Ayes)

b) Approval of the quote from Russ Electric in the amount of \$5,190.00 to install new LED lighting at the Public Works building was moved by Schaden with a second of Anderson. (4 Ayes)

It was noted that there were 3 quotes. Russ Electric's quote included the Focus on Energy rebate.

- c) Daul called for the committee at 5:55 p.m. to convene into Closed Session pursuant to notice duly given and as allowed by Wis. Stats. 19.85(1) (c) for discussion on personal matters: Hire new Public Works employee. Anderson issued second. A roll call vote was taken by Reed. (M/C)
- d) At 6:15 p.m. Anderson motioned to reconvene into Open Session pursuant to notice duly given and as allowed by Wis. Stat. 19.85 (2) for the remainder of the agenda. Daul seconded. (4 Ayes)

- e) Action/Discussion on Matters from Closed Session led to the following result: Anderson motioned to hire the chosen candidate for the job opening as a Public Works employee. Daul called a second. (4 Ayes)
