6. Correspondence

Chief Reed advised that a \$2500 donation was received from the Booster Club for new lights.

7. Review/recommendation on Police, Fire, and Rescue reports

a.+b. Sergeant Ruechel advised that an \$800 savings was made during the radio purchase through Frank's Radio based on the budgeted amount. Chief Reed stated that between the two departments there was a total savings of \$2,000.

Moved by Young, Seconded by Carriveau to approve the Police and Fire radio purchase. 4 ayes Motion carried upon verbal voice vote.

c. Chief Reed spoke on the possibility of purchasing a new trailer that can be filled with equipment. The trailer can be used for an ice rescue and even on scene of a fire for rehab. The benefit would be that the trailer can be left on scene in the event the towing vehicle needs to respond elsewhere. Chief Reed requested to spend up to \$5,000 to purchase the trailer. There is \$5,000 in capital, so this will not affect the budget.

d. Chief Reed advised that the Brush Truck is no longer serviceable. He is requesting it be put up for bids. He will then use the money made from the sale of the Brush Truck to go towards a Wildfire Slide-In.

e. Chief Reed advised that the Wildfire Slide-In can hold 200 gallons of water and 10 gallons of foam. There is suction on it so it can be pulled right up to a water source and filled. Jaws will go on it and

this unit can then pull right up next to a vehicle fire and brush fires. The cost of this will come out of the capital fund.

Moved by Young, Seconded by Carriveau to authorize purchase of Wildfire Slide-In up to \$15,000. 4 ayes. Motion carried upon verbal voice vote.
