- 3.) Olson issued approval of Agenda. Trepanier motioned second. (4 Ayes)
- 4.) Approval of Meeting Minutes from 4/17/2019 was called by Olson with a Viestenz second. (4 Ayes)
- 5.) Public Input: None.
- 6.) Correspondence: Director Bostedt requested the Commission compare and contrast, checking for errors, the old (of 7 years) and new Harbor brochure for the May meeting.
- 7.) Discussion/Recommendation/Action on the Following:
  - a.) City Docks Handicapped Fishing Deck Project—Reed, Superintendent Wusterbarth, and Bostedt got together earlier to discuss the costly issue. The amount was felt to be City excess, even with generous sponsors. It was suggested that we create the fishing deck project like our causeway, at a much less cost: tear out the cement and rip rap it. We still need our dredging money. Wusterbarth will determine a rough estimate to move in this direction. Funds would come out of Capital Equipment. Compared to other City projects, this was thought feasible and within the range of acceptance. Viestenz motioned that the fishing deck project move in a different direction: rip rapping our property line at the City docks property. Olson determined a second. (M/C) Olson and Viestenz thought that we should approach our sponsors after the bidding to rip rap.
  - b.) UPEA Engineering Proposal for City Docks Handicapped Fishing Deck Project was distributed the meeting. It stood at quotes totaling \$158,500.00.
