c. Authorization for funds for EMT training, \$1,400 per person. There is partial funding through grants. The training is required for new EMS personnel. Because of registration time restrictions, some personnel will be trained this year, and the rest will be trained next year.

- 8. Review/recommendation on Police, Fire and Rescue reports Police:
 - -There were 499 calls for service.
 - -Sixty ordinance violations handled.
 - -Officers have been involved in many community activities. Gospel Chapel Family night was attended as well as a flag retirement ceremony. Officers participated in the Color Run by throwing color at runners. The library held a fundraising event and donated money raised to the police department.
 - -Mandatory trainings were attended by all officers. The training involved firearms, instructed by Chief Rehberg, and emergency vehicle operations, instructed by Detective Crocker.
 - -Detective Crocker assisted OFRD with a Stop the Bleed/CPR course.

Fire:

- -Chief Reed has future plans to supply Firefighter VandeVoort with an AED. The reason for this is EMS response in rural areas where life-saving moments matter.
- -Firefighters attended much of the same community events as the police officers did.
- -Fill the Boot was a great success. The MDA representative was very impressed seeing police officers helping the firefighters. She stated she's never seen that before. Total amount raised by OFRD was \$3,927.90, nearly a record high.
- -Some firefighters completed aerial ladder certification.
