

City Park Campground Rules

1. Please drive slowly through the Campground. 5 mph.
2. Drive on the main road and park in your site.
3. Keep your campsite clean.
4. Do not move picnic tables from other campground sites.
5. Place garbage in plastic bags and place in garbage containers. Keep cans separate and place in the designated containers.
6. Take care of your children at all times, children shall not be left unattended.
7. Obey the quiet time of 11pm to 8 am. Campers must be at their campsite. City Park closes at 10 pm.
8. Keep Toilet area clean it's there for your use. Other bathrooms are located in City Park, there open from 8 am to 10 pm.
9. Stay in the designated campground area and do not trespass onto private property. If caught you will be prosecuted to the owners' content.
- 10. Please Do Not:**
 - a. Create a nuisance or disturbance.
 - b. Damage any facilities, wildlife, or vegetation..
 - c. Cut across other people's campsites.
 - d. Move picnic tables.
 - e. Operate any motorized vehicle ex). Mini bike or scooter if not legal on roads.
 - f. Put garbage in fire pits or burn garbage in fire pits.
11. Pets are welcome, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Pets must be controlled on a leash at all times.
 - b. Pets must not annoy or constitute a danger to other guests.
 - c. Owners must clean up after their pets immediately.
 - d. No pets may be tied outside unattended.
11. Capacity: 2 tents per site or 1 pop up camper and 1 tent.
12. Check out time is 12:00 pm; if you do not check out before 12:00 pm you will be charged another day's rent. Cost is \$15 per day. Pay slips are available at the entrance of the campground. Please pay and drop in RED pay pole. Place tab from your pay envelope on your site post. Failure will result in a \$25 dollar fee.
13. One vehicle per site. No parking on roadway or other sites. Additional parking across the way in City Park.

These rules are enforced and are for the purpose of everyone to have a fun and safe stay at City Park Campground.
