CURB-SIDE PICK-UP

Do NOT put out recycling before
 5:00 p.m. the day before
 your scheduled pick-up day.

SCHEDULE

- Every other Wednesday or Thursday
- A street-by-street Recycling Schedule, is available at City Hall.

HOLIDAYS

Holiday pick-ups are included in the Recycling Schedule available at City Hall. If unsure about which day your recycles will be picked up during a holiday week, please call City Hall at 834-7711.

PLASTICS

ACCEPT

- All Food, & Household Bottles & Caps
- Soda, Juice & Water Bottles & Caps
- Plastic Food Jars & Lids
- Dairy Jugs & Caps
- Deli, Bakery, Produce Containers & Lids
- Pill Bottles & Lids (only if recycle symbol)
- ALL Plastics With Any Recycle Symbol

DO NOT ACCEPT

- Plastic Bags of Any Kind
- Plastic Wrap or Film
- Motor Oil Bottles
- Styrofoam
- Packing Peanuts
- Plastic Paint Cans or Lids



GLASS

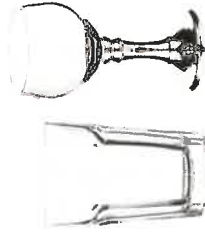
ACCEPT

- Food & Beverage Bottles & Jars



DO NOT ACCEPT

- Window Glass
- Drinking Glasses
- Ceramics or China
- Dishes
- Canning Jars
- Glass Cookware



RECYCLING GUIDELINES

- All recycles can be combined in the same bin.
- Remove labels from cans & bottles.
- Empty and rinse ALL bottles, containers & jars.
- Recycle ALL metal jar caps & lids.
- All recycling must be in a collection bin and not put in cardboard boxes or bags.
- All cardboard no matter how big or small must be broken down flat or it will NOT be picked up.
- Maximum container size to put your recycling in should not exceed 32 gallons.
- Be sure to clean ALL food residue from ALL recycling.
- NEVER put recyclables in plastic bags or cardboard boxes. Bags can damage sorting equipment. Place ALL recyclables in your curb-side collection bin - loosely.
- Recycle plastic shopping bags at the grocery store, or other participating retail location.

PAPER

ACCEPT

- Newspapers & Inserts
- Cardboard & Paperboard (food boxes)
- Junk Mail & Catalogs
- Office & School Paper & Notebooks
- Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons & Caps
- Books (hardcover & softcover)
- Magazines
- Phonebooks
- Pizza Boxes



DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Paper Contaminated with Food or Grease
- Tissue Paper
- Gift Wrap

METALS

ACCEPT:

- Aluminum Bottles & Cans
- Steel, Tin & Bi-metal Cans
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Metal Jar Cans & Lids



DO NOT ACCEPT

- Aluminum Pans or Foil
- Empty Paint Cans or Lids
- Large/Bulky Scrap Metal Items
