 - a.) Anderson called for approval to pay request #2 for the reconstruction of Mott/Mill St from DeGroot Construction in the amount of \$ 263,137.05. Daul called second. (5 Ayes)

b.) Approval of the final pay request to Peter's Concrete Inc. in the amount of \$6,966.15 for the reconstruction of Washburn & Lindsay Ave was motioned by Bronikowski with a Schaden second. (5 Ayes)

Wusterbarth assured the Board that this amount was owed as of yet.

c.) Approval of the invoice from Vermeer in the amount of \$6,500.00 for the rental of the trommel screen (@ 49 hours) for composting was moved to approval by Anderson. Schaden called second.
