\*Narcan purchased to supplement current supply. All officers completed refresher training.  
  
Fire:  
For the month:  
-87 ambulance calls, 115 ahead of last year  
-106 fire calls. 1,028 total for the year. 162 calls ahead of last year.  
  
\*Wednesday night training is still on hold because of the virus, so the department is working on getting virtual training for POC's.  
\*Overtime is decreasing.  
\*LUCAS devices are in place in the ambulance and being used.  
\*The new ambulance arrived last week.
