#### Police:

For the month:

  - -Large quantity of drugs and IED's were found at the Hansen Ave. residence. Brown County Bomb Squad responded.
- -Officers had 6 Narcan saves.

## <u>Fire</u>:

For the month:

- -95 total EMS calls
- -29 NIFRS calls
- -POC interview process
- -Annual hose testing completed by career and POC staff.
  - -3,500 feet of hose was tested in 5 hours.
  - -15 members completed this, 5 hours of overtime was paid to each.

- -Fire inspections continue. Ordinance reminders have been mailed out.
- -The 2004 ambulance has two interested parties to purchase it. An offer of \$7,000 has been given.
