8. Review/recommendation on Police, Fire and Rescue reports
Police:
For the month:
 - An interdiction occurred in the city with help from Oconto, Florence, Forest, and Marinette counties.
 - 172 vehicles stopped
 - 41 K9 indications
 - Fatal overdoses on Pecor St. and Hansen Ave.
 - Large quantity of drugs and IED's were found at the Hansen Ave. residence. Brown County Bomb Squad responded.
 - Officers had 6 Narcan saves.
Fire:
For the month:
 - 95 total EMS calls
 - 29 NIFRS calls
 - POC interview process
 - Annual hose testing completed by career and POC staff.
 - 3,500 feet of hose was tested in 5 hours.
 - 15 members completed this, 5 hours of overtime was paid to each.

- Fire inspections continue. Ordinance reminders have been mailed out.
- The 2004 ambulance has two interested parties to purchase it. An offer of \$7,000 has been given.

Training:

- Annual training requirements completed.
 - HIPAA and Bloodborne Pathogens
- Apparatus obstacle course in the parking lot of Cruiser's
- Fire Chief's conference

Community Events:

 - Extra support from surrounding agencies during event.
