## AN ORDINANCE REGARDING REVISIONS TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE IN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF OCONTO

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCONTO, OCONTO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I. **REVISION.** Section 13-1-200(I) of the City of Oconto Code of Ordinances is revised as follows:

Sec. 13-1-200. - Accessory Uses or Structures.

(I) Temporary Tent / Structure. Tents or other temporary structures may be used for the storage of vehicles or other materials for a period of six (6) months, from either April 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> or October 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>. Temporary structures, tent, and similar devises, if used for storage, must be placed in the rear of the lot, and must be adequately secured to the ground and must be maintained in a reasonable appearance. Permitting shall be required for each six-month period beginning April 1<sup>st</sup> or October 1<sup>st</sup>, and the tent / structure is subject at all times to inspection by the Building Inspector. A non-profit organization or corporation required to obtain a permit as to a temporary tent / structure shall be exempt as to the corresponding fee.

## II. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be adopted under suspension of local rules, and shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
