

**PARK & REC. COMMITTEE MINUTES**  
**THURSDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2022 @ 5 P.M.**

- 1.) Sue Anderson, Chairman, called the meeting order.
  
- 2.) Roll Call: Sue Anderson, Todd Hearley, Bob LeBreck, Diane Motiff, Lori Stenstrup  
Also Present: Director of Park, Rec., and Forestry John Bostedt; City Administrator Brittney Bickel;  
23 citizens (campers and local residents)
  
- 3.) **Hearley moved for approval of Agenda; Motiff called second. (5 Ayes)**
  
- 4.) Public Input: Six members of the public in attendance spoke. With request of a Committee member, Director Bostedt gave history of Holtwood Campground up to the 11 years he has been in position, and his experience since. He covered upkeep, the campers themselves, building up the property, cleaning routine, and sweeping the property for safety. Each member of the Committee also spoke to the public dialogue, including the amenities used by non-campers.

- 6.) **Discussion/Recommendation/Action on the Following:**  
Holtwood Campground: 2023 Holtwood Campground Rates and all public voice was addressed by Chairman Anderson. She addressed utility rates as the main reason for raising prices. She also informed that rates may well be raised again next year and that the existing budget returns to Campground improvements. It was stated that the Budget was returned to the Committee for review and accumulation of more data. It was impressed upon those present that their best interest is and has been in the hands of the existing Committee. Following more discussion by the Committee, **LeBreck motioned to return our original suggestion of a 10% increase in camping prices for the 2023 Budget initially offered to the City Council. Hearley voiced the second. (5 Ayes)**
