



## The Harbor Town of Oconto . . .

Located in Northeast Wisconsin, Oconto lies on the spectacular shores of the Bay of Green Bay. With a population of just over 4,500, Oconto is a quick 30 minute drive north of the bustling City of Green Bay. Situated between dense forests, beautiful wetlands and stunning shorelines. Oconto is considered by many to be the start of the true Wisconsin Northwoods, but still has access to the amenities of larger cities.

The Oconto Marsh is on the Great Wisconsin Birding & Nature Trail. With more than 33 sites on the National Register of Historic Places, you'll see right away why Oconto embodies "History on the Bay".

If water is what you are after, look no further. Whatever water adventure you're searching for, you will find it here! Bring whatever type of watercraft you may have, come on out and enjoy the waters of the Oconto River and Bay of Green Bay. For canoe, kayak & tube rentals, go to Holtwood Campground in the city for a river adventure up the Oconto river or down river to the harbor.

Follow Main Street/County Road Y east out of town and turn right after the marina onto Harbor Road to find the Oconto Harbor & Breakwater Park, with six boat ramps, 50 slips, public fish cleaning station, handicap observation/fishing pier and quick access to the Bay. From there, sail or motor away to Door County with direct Lake Michigan access in Sturgeon Bay, the state of Michigan, or the City of Green Bay! A short distance before the Harbor Road turn, turn right on Park Lane, next to the marina to City Docks, where you will find an alternate boat launch/dock that is handicap accessible.

Bring your fishing pole to Oconto and you will soon find out why we are the unofficial Walleye Capital of the World!

## Directions ~

### FROM THE SOUTH

Hwy 41 North, take the first Oconto exit onto Business 41, go right at the stoplights onto Main Street/County Road Y. Continue driving east thru downtown and then out of town to Harbor Road. Turn right onto Harbor Road.

### FROM THE NORTH

Hwy 41 South, take the 2nd Oconto exit, Hwy 22 - thru two roundabouts east toward Oconto. Pass straight thru stoplights. Hwy 22 turns into Main Street/County Road Y. Continue driving east thru downtown and then out of town to Harbor Road. Turn right onto Harbor Road.

### FROM THE WEST

Hwy 22 East, thru 2 roundabouts toward Oconto. Pass straight thru stoplights. Hwy 22 turns into Main Street/County Road Y. Continue driving east thru downtown and then out of town to Harbor Road. Turn right onto Harbor Road.
