The Applicant hereby agrees that he will sign and barricade the work site according to the latest Wisconsin Department of Transportation Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and is liable for all damages for failure to erect and maintain suitable barricades, signs, and lights. The Applicant is liable for all costs of restoration and repairs to damaged facilities, streets, sidewalks, C&G, landscaping and will be billed for these costs if completed by the City of Oconto. Applicant shall pay the cost for relocation of the permitted facility except as limited by Chapter PSC 130 of the State of Wisconsin Administrative Code. The City reserves the right to require relocation of a facility at no cost to the City if the facility interferes with future development or improvements to the infrastructure of the City Streets and/or City Utility Systems. The Applicant hereby certifies that he has the appropriate Bond and Certificate of Insurance filed with the City of Oconto.

Applicant must provide a letter to all property owners in the permitted project area with the type of work they will perform and how it may affect them before any work begins.

PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE:

- \$286.00 for 500 feet max / including 1 road crossing.
\$10.00 each for additional 100 feet laterally.
\$75.00 each for additional road crossings.
Sidewalk must be replaced if cored or damaged.
Handicap ramps need a detectible warning field (yellow) installed if removed or damaged.

Permit fee for each underground utility installation project must be received before the project can start.
