6. Director's Report

Amy Peterson, Library Director reported to the Board of Trustees...

Amy emailed the following report to the Trustees on June 28, 2023.

June went fast and according to our daily visit counter, we have definitely seen an increase in daily traffic to the library. We did host 3 summer school classes daily from June 12-23. Amanda worked really hard to make her 2 classes do some cool activities and she had some kids with lots of energy. She did a great job keeping up with all of them and keeping them engaged. This seems to be a good fit for the school district also and I anticipate this partnership will continue next summer.

Oconto Area Chamber -many of the members decorated their sidewalks. We also collected ads and made the Rummage Sale Map for City Wide Rummage Sales on Copperfest weekend. The Oconto County Economic Development Office printed copies of the maps for us. We estimate we gave out around 900 maps from the library and area businesses.

On Tuesday, June 20 we started doing a Storytime on the Steps at the Beyer Home. The first one was a little slow, but last night (June 27) we had a great turnout. This will continue on Tuesday nights until mid/late August. Also on Tuesday nights we are doing a craft table at Tunes on Tuesday. We have had a decent turnout the first 2 weeks. This will continue until the last Tunes on Tuesday on August 15.

Finally -also on Tuesdays - Hands on Deck from Green Bay will be outside at the library every Tuesday afternoon from 1-5. Kids/Families can work on maritime skills- navigation, marine biology, knot tying, model building and electric circuits. Once they have tried all 5 skills they earn a card for a free boat ride – which can be done from Oconto on a sailboat or from Green Bay on a larger fishing boat. This is all done free for the libraries and families.

We are planning on doing craft and information tables at Waterfest on July 3 and Little River Pancake Breakfast on July 8. We are trying to attend as many community events as we can to help spread the word that the library is here.

The new library website is up and running. I have not made many changes to the original design – more to come on this, hopefully soon.

- 9. City Public Works Department installed a new handicap parking spot sign and pole. Our pole was rusty and the old sign and pole were stolen in June. The City Crew also removed the unwanted trees in the back fenced area of the building.
