### Volunteers Urgently Needed for the Following Positions in Your Community:



#### Disaster Client Health Services

Licensed healthcare professionals needed to provide hands on care, health assessments, education and guidance to clients.

Preferred Commitment: Locally – Monthly shift calendar available to support local disaster responses. All volunteers are encouraged to sign up for a minimum of one shift per month. Nationally – Minimum 2 week commitment working 10- or 12-hour shifts.



#### Disaster Client Mental Health Services

Licensed mental health professionals are needed to support individuals and families who have been impacted by disaster and provide support to other volunteers.

Preferred Commitment: Locally – Monthly shift calendar available to support local disaster responses. All volunteers are encouraged to sign up for a minimum of one shift per month. Nationally – Minimum 2 week commitment working 10- or 12-hour shifts.



#### Disaster Spiritual Care

Providing disaster spiritual care support to individuals and families who have been impacted by a disaster.

Preferred Commitment: Locally – Monthly shift calendar available to support local disaster responses. All volunteers are encouraged to sign up for a minimum of one shift per month. Nationally – Minimum 2 week commitment working 10- or 12-hour shifts.
